

ALLAN FELS

Professor Allan Fels, is Dean of the Australia and New Zealand School of Government (ANZSOG). This is a flagship institution established by the governments of Australia, New Zealand, Victoria, South Australia, New South Wales, Queensland and Western Australia, and fifteen leading universities and business schools. It provides senior management development programs for top-level public servants.

Professor Fels was Chairman of the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission from 1995 until June 2003 and prior to that he was Chairman of the Trade Practices Commission from 1991 to 1995 and Chairman of the Prices Surveillance Authority from 1989 to 1992. He was Co-Chair of the OECD Trade and Competition Committee from 1996 to 2003.

In 2006, Professor Fels served the Australian government as Head of the Consumer and Privacy Taskforce on the Access Card. This was a part-time position. He also chaired the Steering Committee of the Victorian Government Stronger Community Organisations Project (SCOP) in 2008.

He is a Fellow of the Australian Academy of Social Science and he was awarded the Order of Australia (AO) in 2001
