Mr. Phillips is a graduate of the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor (B.S. Economics, 1970) and Stanford University Law School (J.D., 1974). He was employed by the United States Federal Trade Commission from 1974-1985, where he held a variety of jobs in the areas of competition and consumer policy.
