Lerzan KAYIHAN ÜNAL is currently working at the International Relations Department of the Turkish Competition Authority as a Senior Competition Expert. She is responsible for competition law and policy issues not only with respect to ICN, OECD, UNCTAD and EU affairs, but also for bilateral relations with the relevant national competition agencies including providing technical assistance and training programs/seminars to members of those agencies. During her service of 11 years, she was also assigned as a case handler at the department in charge of transport, financial services and services sectors. She worked at the Competition and Consumer Policies Branch of UNCTAD at the UN Office in Geneva where she focused on the role of the SMEs in developing countries, relation between competition and the business environment for SMEs in Turkey and the preparation of country profiles in competition law and consumer protection of various countries. She was also employed at ILO-IPEC to analyse various problems of Sub-Saharan African countries with respect to the development of the national economies in this region. Before joining the Turkish Competition Authority, she worked at Ernst&Young.
