

SHAN RAMBURUTH

Shan Ramburuth is currently the Commissioner of the Competition Commission SA. He was previously the CEO and Registrar of Competition Tribunal SA, a position he held from the inception of the institution in 1999 until April 2005.

During the years 1994 – 1999, Shan worked at the National Economic Development and Labour Council (NEDLAC), where he facilitated trade and industry policy development notably on the SA/EU and SADC trade negotiations, competition policy, skills development and environmental management policy.

Prior to 1994, Shan worked in the non-governmental sector particularly in organizations dealing with education, health and HIV/AIDS. He worked on a national HIV/AIDS programme from 1990 to 1994.

Shan graduated from the University of the Witwatersrand with a BSc (Biochemistry) in 1989 and a Masters Degree in Public and Development Management in 1997.
